We have taken on board your comments from the last period and you will notice some small changes. We will check in with you all in a few weeks for some more feedback. THE LEARNING PIT

As you start to tackle remote learning at home together, as stated in the newsletter sent home on Monday, your job as a parent is to motivate your child and create a sense of self efficacy; that is the 'you can do it' attitude. If your child is getting 100% of their work 'correct', they aren't learning any new concepts. We want them to struggle with a few concepts in their work because that's when they are challenged and they learn new concepts. Prompt them with questions like.....

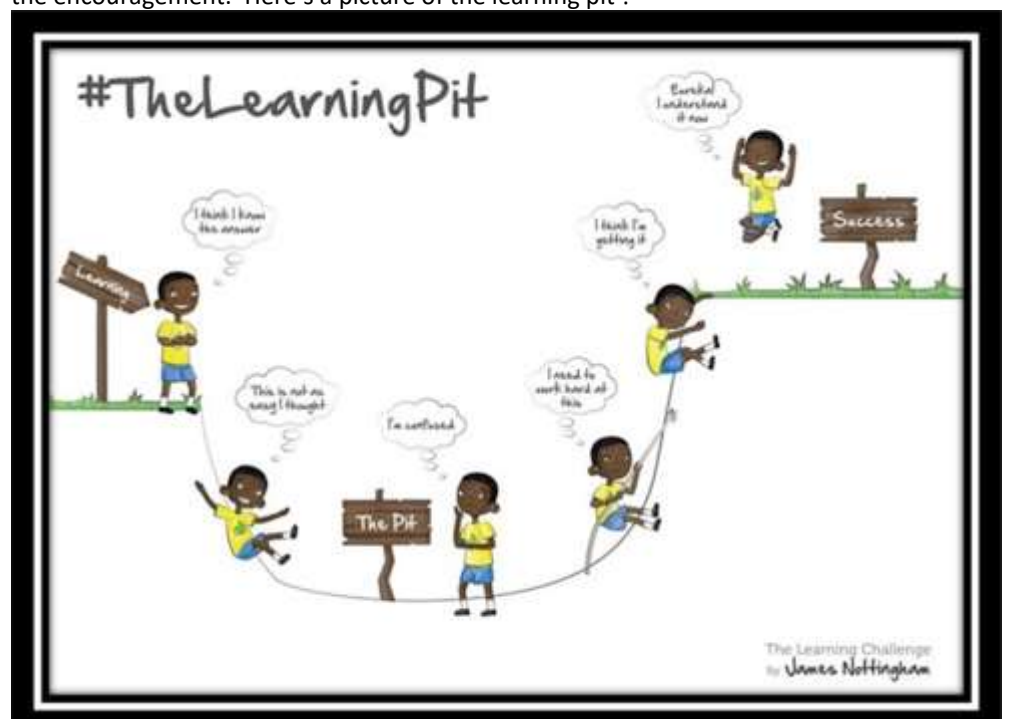
- Have you seen a question like this before ?
- What do you already know about this ?
- What do you need to be able to work it out ?
- Who or where can you get some help ?
- What did you do last time when things got tough ?

Don't just tell them the answer ... prompt them to seek help themselves while providing the encouragement. Here's a picture of the learning pit !

There's a white mountain.

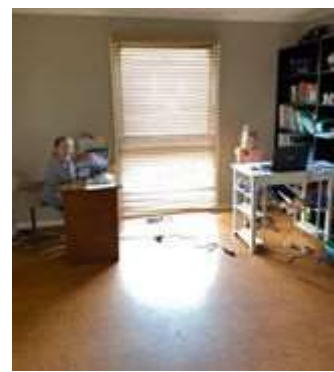
